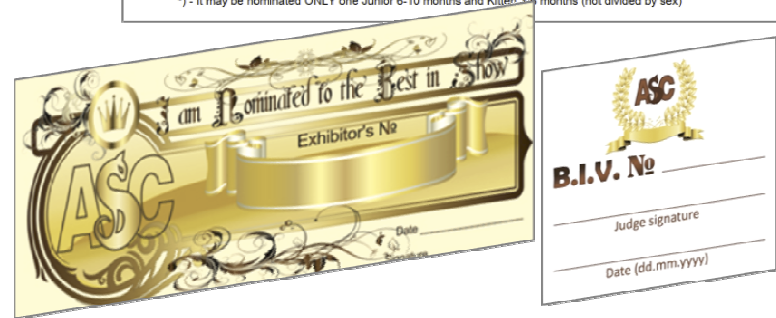

09/10	CAC CAP	This class is open to cats of ages of at least 10 months at the time of the show. In this class a CAC / CAP is awarded
11		This class is open to cats aged 6 months at the time of the show, but not yet 10 months old
12		This class is open to cats aged 3 months at the time of the show, but not yet 6 months old
18	Vet	Additional show class. Exhibits in additional class - Veteran will only be classified I, II, III and IV, but will not receive a qualification. In case of a class larger than 4 entries, all other exhibits in this class will be classified V (joint 5th place).

Show qualifications, titles and classes for House cats.

At ASC shows house cats are given the titles the same as the pedigree cats.

House cats must be neutered before the age of 10 months. However, their certificates are similar to those for adult cats. Only the second letter C of the certificate's abbreviation stands for the word "Companion". Thus, the certificates awarded will be similar to the certificates of pedigreed cats - see the table below.

The judge must not to remember a group numbers. He'll see there in the protocol. According to number group a judge defines which colors are identical

In all categories every class, from 01 to 12 , are subdivided according to breed, variety (color or color group) and gender

The official documents and judge's reports contain at least the following data:

- place and date of the show
- catalogue number of the cat to be judged
- designation of breed and color (EMS-code)
- group number (where applicable)
- date of birth
- gender
- class in which the cat is to be judged.

Example 2. The Judge's sheet: the category (2)

Judge's choice. **About Show qualifications and certificates**

Precondition for this example:

Everyone of cats are very nice 😊

No 3 – He hasn't competitors, claims the certificate CAC (show class – 09³), so he gets assessment Ex1 and CAC

No 16 & 17. They are adult male with the same breed and group of color (VI) and they claim the certificates CAC.

No 16 is a little bit better than No 17. In result No 16 gets Ex1 and CAC. No 17 gets Ex 2 (without title)

No 18, 19 & 20. There are adult females with the same breed and group of color (VI) and they claim the certificate breed and group of color (VI) and they claim the certificate CAC.

In result **No 18** gets Ex1 and CAC, No 19 – Ex2 and No 20 gets EX3.

No 21 & 22. They are juniors with the same group of color (VI). It doesn't matter that they are of the same or of different sex because they are of adults. One of them (No 21, for ex.) better than other. In result **No 21** gets Ex1 and No 22 gets Ex2

No 27 – It hasn't competitors, claims the certificate CAC (show class – '09'), so she gets assessment Ex1 and CAC.

No 29 - It hasn't competitors and gets assessment Ex1
